RADIO BROADCASTING Continued on Government Radio Stations

Voice of Peace continued broadcasting daily on six government radio stations in 2015, as well as broadcasting weekly on eight more stations. At the end of the year, selected local radio stations, including VOP, were getting ready to be back on the air.

VOP FOLLOW UP MINISTRY IN PRISONS

Especially in Udonthani, our project worker, Mr. Somwang continues to see much fruit of the ministry to prisoners. Somwang visits at least once a month for worship and teaching, and the Christian groups within the prison meets regularly. VOP team visits at least once a year, normally in connection with a Christmas and New Year celebration, when we bring gifts to the Christians.
